MINUTES

The meeting was called to order by President Iona Scapple at 5:45 PM. Quorum confirmed.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES of Feb 5, 2013. MPS MC/JM. Two corrections: funding approval for Ina's Interpreter Position-\$6,000 and \$4,500 for display cases for Museum at Mtn. Station were approved in February.

- Guest speaker Art Davis presented a plan to increase traffic to our MSJNHA.org website. He stated the way you increase traffic on our website is being first on the Google page when certain key words are used. There is a cost per hit charge by Google.
 The Board decided not to spend more money on the website at this time, but to improve traffic by adding more links from other key sites such as: links from PSAT, PS Chamber of Commerce, Friends of Desert Mountains and other State Parks.
- II. STATE PARK REPORT, Bart Grant, Supv. Ranger
 - A. Bart read a Thank You letter from Garratt who is moving to a new position and will no longer be part of our SP.
 - B. General Jackson, the new CA State Park Director recently visited Idyllwild SP and wants the Idyllwild HQ improvement project back on line and said he will get the "green light" from Sacramento.
 - C. Funding for Taxidermy of various animal specimens on ice at Lake Perris SP were approved up to \$2000 and including \$750 for bird specimens. Gene Cardiff of SB County Museum will be our taxidermist.
 - D. All the items on the March 5 State Park agenda were approved for a total of up to \$12,500. Motion EV KL/MM. These include 1) Idyllwild Interpretive Program Supplies, \$3,134.
 2) Visitor Center Kiosk Upgrades Staff, Rob Howard, \$3,000.
 3) VC Display Cases Mtn. Station-Staff, Rob Howard, (\$4,500 previously approved in January).
 4) Taxidermy as discussed above, \$2,000.
 5) Rescue gear, Staff: Aaron Gray & Todd Friedman, \$1,850.
 6) Ham Radio Equipment Staff: Aaron & Todd, \$400.
 7) Crosscut Saws (2) for Idyllwild & Long Valley, \$800.
 8) Table Saw for Long Valley, Staff:Bart, \$700.
 9) Misc. Carpentry Tools for Long Valley Ranger Station, \$500.
 Total: \$12,384

 - G. On May 13 the Amgen Bike Race will finish Stage 2 cycling up Tramway Rode to finish at Valley Station. The Road will be closed to traffic and a shuttle is being arranged for visitor and supporters to watch the finish of Stage 2.
